## Overview of Programs

Each program focuses on character, integrity, teamwork, communication, problem-solving, creativity, inclusion, action, vision, and reflection. In each session, the career path of every participant will be incorporated into each of these areas.

8th grade through Junior College Level students will learn real life leadership and soft-skills, and a community service project will be selected by the participants that must be completed before the graduation ceremony that will take place at the last class.

## TLT Unlocking The Future Program

This program was developed to provide the underserved youth 8th grade through Junior College level, at no cost, basic life soft-skills, higher education and career readiness through group discussions, hands on exercises, and includes civic responsibility opportunities right in their community. Each session will complete a community project.

## TLT Leaders Program

This program is to give the opportunity to provide the youth with higher education, career readiness, leadership techniques, and civic responsibility opportunities and other issues impacting their community.

A community project is incorporated in each session that will be completed prior to graduation.

## TLT Leading Leaders Intern Program

Students from Collin and Denton Counties, Texas high schools, colleges and universities can apply to take part in a hands-on internship opportunity, giving valuable work experience, insight into a potential career path, developing and refine skills, gain confidence, team-building, and professional relationships.

## TLT Youth & Adult Leadership Academy

Participants and a parent or guardian will meet emerging community and business leaders who encourage them to learn, question, dream, and care about their community.

Each session explores different topics, that will include leadership dynamics, social service organizations, servant leadership, community growth and education, community health and safety, community government, and community culture and leisure. Each member will work with their class building on and using their leadership skills to complete a class project that will benefit the community.
