Key responsibilities:

Work Schedule:

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

Attend a weekly virtual team meeting every Tuesday. (Options: Tues 9:30am, Tues 11am, Tues 1pm, Tues 230pm, Tues 4-5pm, or Tues 7pm)

Participate in a one-on-one virtual coaching session with your supervisor every two weeks.

Work hours are flexible, but you must commit to working 10-20 hours per week.

Applicants must reside in Texas and have U.S. work authorization that does not, now or in the future, require sponsorship.

Responsibilities will include:

- Support planning and coordination of a program and its activities
- Assist with outreach to the community
- Provide specialized administrative support in the development, implementation, and marketing of program function
- Coordinate activities of support staff, consultants, faculty, and/or volunteers engaged in implementation and administration of program objectives
- Write, edit, and coordinate development of course catalogs, promotional materials, educational materials, training manuals, newsletters, and/or brochures, as appropriate to the program

- Maintain program records, including list of equipment and supplies needed by the staff and program,
- Prepare special and/or one-time reports, summaries, or replies to inquiries
- Gather and compute various data, provide data to other departments as needed
- Help build positive relations within the team and external parties
- Support growth and program development

- Strong analytical skills
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written
- Strong problem-solving skills
- Detail-oriented and efficient
- Ability to coordinate and organize meetings and/or special events.
- Strong interpersonal and the ability to work effectively with a wide range of constituencies in a diverse community
- Records maintenance skills

- Self-motivation
- Administrative and clerical skills
