-Developing the tools, templates, and training materials to help our team create scaled, online and in-person, social, and interactive learning experiences -Bringing your skills to a team of passionate educators and consultants to help build a learning design function

-Creating e-learning course presentations, lessons, and/or courses

-Create course material, templates, and checklists

-Help develop standards and practices for the development and improvement of courses and curriculum

-Build out, and conduct a webinar
