One-Hour long virtual weekly team meeting Options: Tues 9:30am, Tues 11am, Tues 1pm, Tues 230pm, and Tues 4pm **AND**

Bi-weekly one-on-one virtual coaching sessions held under the supervision of a supervisor.

May 20th to July 27th, check your vacation schedule prior to applying. Work hours are flexible, but you must <u>commit to working 10-20 hours per week.</u>

Applicants must reside in Texas and have a previously approved US work authorization that does not, now or in the future, require sponsorship.

Responsibilities will include:

-Create internship program process, which included organization of training workshops and planning of community service events and extracurricular activities, welcome bags, facilitator manual and orientation
