Work Schedule:

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

One-Hour long virtual weekly team meeting

Options: Tues 9:30am, Tues 11am, Tues 1pm, Tues 230pm, and Tues 4pm

AND

Bi-weekly one-on-one virtual coaching sessions
held under the supervision of a supervisor.

May 20th to July 27th, check your vacation schedule prior to applying.

Work hours are flexible, but you must commit to working 10-20 hours per week.

Applicants must reside in Texas and have a previously approved US work authorization that does not, now or in the future, require sponsorship.

Responsibilities will include:

- Learn and use project management software
- Document and track progress of project milestones
- Identify project scope, cost, risks, constraints, dependencies, assumptions, and deadlines
- Analyze resource need and availability for each program
- Organize and schedule team meetings
- Obtain weekly project status updates from all team members
- Provide consistent updates on projects to all stakeholders
- Measure project performance and suggest areas of improvement

Qualifications:

- Self-starter who can produce great results with limited supervision

- Strong written and oral communication skills and ability to present in meetings
- Attention to detail and extremely organized
- Proficient with Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint
