




Self Reported by Interns



Age Brackets





Low and Moderate-Income Participant Results



Since 2019, TLT has focused on serving those in low-and-moderate income communities.

In 2023, we were at 59.26% and as of December 2024, we are at 99%.



Our Programs

TLT Kids Serve is a volunteer program where youth 5th grade to 9th grade participates in volunteer project. These projects are in partnership with other nonprofits, completed in a classroom setting and include a financial literacy lesson and/or a real-life or soft-skill lesson.



The **Veterans Gateway** brings veterans together to support and mentor one another. Our organization is driven by the belief that veterans should not have to face the challenges of civilian life alone. By offering mentorship, training, and networking opportunities, we aim to empower veterans and provide them with the resources they need to transition successfully.

Our Leading Leaders Intern Program strives to provide each young adult participant, ages 17, and older, in Texas, the hands-on, entry level, opportunities to gain valuable experience to integrate with their career path in mind while developing leadership qualities and skills with hands-on curriculum-based opportunities.
